AMENDMENT TO CHAT UPDATE NO 12 REGARDING HEALTHCARE

The Chillington Health Centre advised CHAT by email on the 21st June 2016 that they considered Update No 12 to be inaccurate and requested it was corrected.

CORRECTIVE STATEMENT

We have received an assurance from the Chillington Health Centre that they are **not oversubscribed and that increasing numbers will not put pressure on the Healthcare professionals.**

- An increase of patients for the Health Centre would mean an increase in funding.
- With an increase in funding they would be able to further develop the service.

The Health Centre has assured us that any unplanned increase in the population of Chillington would not potentially put patients' lives at risk.

They were concerned it may scare patients and cause them unnecessary worry. Be harmful to peoples' health and wellbeing and could cause them to register at other practices for fear that their health needs may not be met, which would be detrimental to the Health Centre

This was certainly not the intention of CHAT therefore we have agreed with the Health Centre request to produce a Corrective Statement.

To meet the Health Centre request for a Corrective Statement, please amend CHAT Update No 12 distributed on the 1st June 2016 as follows:

Page 10

Line 1. Delete "is already oversubscribed and"

Line 2. Delete "Increasing patient numbers at this time would put even more pressure on all healthcare professionals".

Line 9. Insert full stop after "carefully".

Line 10. Delete "because patients lives' could potentially be put at risk".

With regard to the village response to this Planning Application, CHAT is very encouraged by the 200 plus (and still counting) number of fantastic heartfelt, varied and detailed objections submitted to SHDC by Chillington residents and the unanimous support given by the Stokenham Parish Council at the Chillington Village Hall on Thursday the 16th June 2016.
